About the Course

Designed for

This is a course with a high level of practical content, aimed at those who have not used Dreamweaver CS4 before.

Teaching Approach

The teaching approach contains a mix of lectures, practical, and one-to-one work and varies according to the people attending. For the most part, candidates are able to work at a pace which best suits them, and emphasis is placed upon quality of learning, rather than quantity.

Pre-requirements

Attendees should be familiar with using the Internet. This course does not require knowledge of HTML, but attendees with HTML knowledge will find Dreamweaver easier to use. Prior completion of our 1-day HTML course is recommended but not compulsory.

Course Material

A large part of this course is spent developing professional-looking web pages using Adobe Dreamweaver CS4 with a set of specially prepared exercises and projects. Professionally presented course notes are provided and these may be retained for reference afterwards.
